**Paper Tigers** takes a look into the lives of six students at Lincoln Alternative High School in Walla Walla, WA. The documentary follows the students over the course of a school year, as the staff implement a new approach to discipline, one based on understanding and treatment rather than judgment and suspension. **Paper Tigers** is the story of how one school was able to make a dramatic change and how just one caring adult can help break the cycle of adversity in a young person's life.
